## Christmas Memorial Candles



Christmas is a time when we remember family and friends who have gone before us. Whether we have been bereaved recently or in the past, it's always good to remember our loved ones and doing so, in our spiritual home, helps us to experience healing and peace.

Our red sanctuary lamp memorial candles and the list of names of people they represent, decorate our church beautifully for Christmas. The lamps burn for 7-9 days from Christmas Eve until New Year.

If you would like to order your memorial candles, they cost £7.00 each or £12.00 for two. Please put your money into one of red envelopes with the names of your loved ones you are remembering (either individual names or a family name) stating which Wallsend Church you would like your candles to be placed in for Christmas. All envelopes were taken last week so there are now more red envelopes at the back of church.

Please give your envelopes to Fr David by November 14th so the candles can be ordered.
